1 Welcome/Introduction

This Technical Guide is for the information of participants competing in the Auscycling Qld Cyclocross State Championships 2022 at Ipswich Cycle Park on August 14th 2022.

Ipswich Cycling Club is proud to again host the Auscycling QLD State Championships for 2022. We have brought the Qld State Champs back to its origins in Ipswich and look forward to making use of the great Ipswich Cycle Park facility.

2 Event Details

2.1. Event Description

Ipswich Cycling Club is hosting the Auscycling Qld Cyclocross State Championships 2022. This will be a Silver event and therefore will be conducted under the guidance of the AusCycling Technical Regulations.

Official Practice will be held on Sunday August 14th 9:30am to 10:30am and 1:00pm to 1:30pm. Additional practice time may be available between races.

2.6. Course Location & Maps

The course will consist of some smooth tarmac on the Ipswich Cycle Park criterium crit, mainly use of the grass infield within the criterium circuit bounds, including traversing the drainage ditches which are present. The course will also use a small section of single track through the treed area beside Deebing Creek.

2.7. Facilities

2.7.1 Toilets

Toilets are located near to the finish line and rego desk. Shown on the map in Appendix B

2.7.2 Food vendors

There will be coffee and available from Our Coffee Coven (TBC) and Got Smoke (TBC) at the main staging area adjacent to the Finish line.

2.7.3 Water

Drinking water is available from the water fountain between the main staging area near the Finish line and the rego area.

2.7.4 Spectator viewing areas

Spectators may view the race from any location around the course, provided they maintain a safe distance from the course and do not impede or assist any rider.

3 Competitor Information

3.1. Technical Regulations

The event will be conducted under the guidance of the [AusCycling Technical Regulations](#) both General and Cyclo-cross specific. This includes regulations on start areas, call-ups, race duration, pit areas, equipment and any other technical information not outlined in this document.

3.1.1 Tyre Width

Tyre width for Elite and U23 categories will adhere to UCI regulations, with a maximum width of 33mm measured at the widest point. U17, U19 and all Masters 1-8 categories will be allowed a maximum width of 50mm, measured at the widest point. The U7, U9, U11, U13, U15 and Open categories will have no maximum limit on tyre width.

3.2. Registration

Participants must pre-register for the event prior to midnight August 11th via the Auscycling Event portal at [AusCycling Event Portal](#). No on the day entries will be taken.

The operation hours of registration are outlined in the Event Schedule (See Appendix A). The Registration area will be utilised for the distribution of race plates and numbers only.

3.3. Categories

The Series categories are based on a riders age as at the 31 December 2023. The Series will recognise categories on UCI age categories as outlined in Table 2.

Masters riders may elect to race in the Elite category for the event.

Categories may be combined for race starts, in accordance with the AusCycling Technical Regulations but are to be awarded separately (Masters 1-3, Master 4+ etc).

3.4. Club/Other Categories

Men's and Women's Open categories will be available for riders wishing to enter on any bike. These categories will be held as non championship categories.

3.5. Prize Money/Prizes

State Championship medals will be awarded for 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place riders by Auscycling to all championship categories from U9 through to Masters 8, including Elite. U7 riders will all receive lolly bags and Open category riders will be awarded 1st prize – 4 pack 4Hearts beer, 2nd prize – Bike wash, 3rd prize – Trek water bottle.

3.6. Presentations

Presentation ceremonies will take place at the main staging area adjacent to the finish line.

All riders who finish 1st to 3rd in all categories should be present at the presentation.

3.7. First Aid/Medical Services

Professional medical services will be provided by Sports First Aid Services. They will be onsite from village opening to village close.

3.8. Race Timers

The event will be timed, recorded, displayed and publicised by Ipswich Cycling Club.

3.9. Anti-Doping Testing

All competitors may be subject to anti-doping testing under AusCycling and Sport Integrity Australia regulations. If you are an Elite Rider you must apply for a pre-event TUE.
